## RESORT TOWN FACING BANKRUPTCY TO MEET WITH COMPANIES IT OWES MONEY

McCall Mayor Bill Robertson says the city will try to come up with a way to pay as much as it can legally pay. Late last month US District Judge B- Lynn Winnill ordered the city to immediately pay the money to Employers Insurance of Wausau and Saint Clair Contractors, Incorporated.
